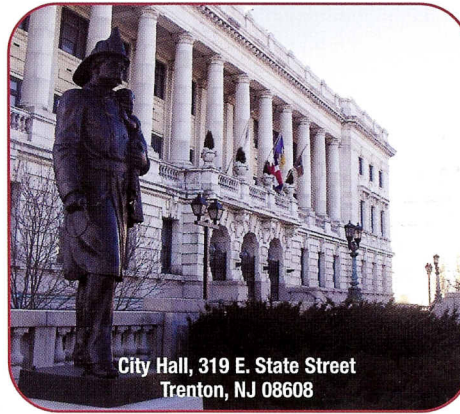


**T**he State Capital occupies a unique place in American history due to the fateful encounter between the American and Hessian forces on Christmas Day in 1776.
